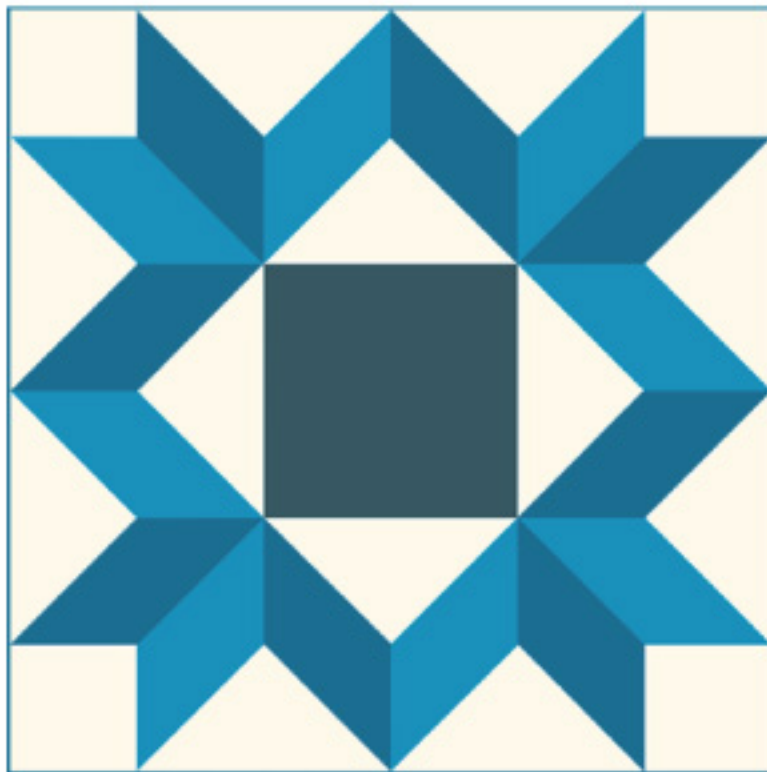


The Dove at the Window Block

Will make a lap size quilt of aprox. 48"x48"

Mini-Blocks Used:
"Triangle Squares"
"Chevrons" and "Cat's Head"

Materials Needed

Print #1 (center)	1/2 yard (18 inches)
Fabric #2 (dark)	2/3 yard (24 inches)
Fabric #3 (light)	2/3 yard (24 inches)
Background fabric	1 1/2 yard (40 inches)
Thread to match (white, natural or match #2 print)	1 spool
Backing 42" fabric	2 yards
Batting	enough for a 50x50 quilt

Cutting Instructions

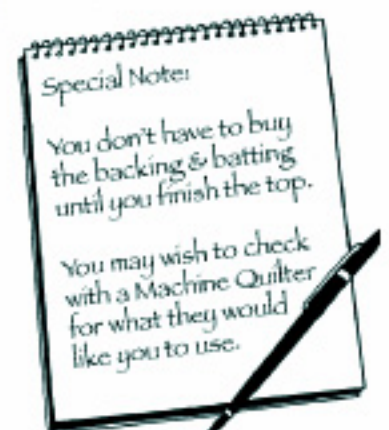
Cut one 16 1/2" square from Print #1 for center square.

You will cut 9 1/2" strips of all the following fabrics:

(See illustration 1 on next page)

Fabric #2 (dark)	2 strips (8 sqs.)
Fabric #3 (light)	2 strips (8 sqs.)
Background fabric	3 strips (12 sqs.)

Cut these strips into 9 1/2" squares.



Cutting Instructions

For corner squares:

Background fabric

Cut one 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (8 sqs.)
And cut into 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Sewing and additional cutting Instructions

Following the Tri-Square instructions

Sew together all the 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares—one background fabric square and one (light or dark) fabric square. Once you have the Tri-Sqs pressed open then you will trim the squares to 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Following the instructions for Chevrons and Cat's Heads

Assemble the Tri-Sqs into FOUR Cat's Head mini-blocks, and FOUR Chevron mini-blocks. Press all seams toward darkest color.

Assembling the Quilt Top

Lay blocks out to resemble the illustration on Page 1.

This quilt is assembled in a 9-patch style.

First Row: Sew one Cat's Head and one Chevron together, press seam toward cat's head block. Then sew another Cat's Head to the other side of the chevron, press seam toward cat's head.

Second Row: Sew a chevron to the Center square, press toward center square. Then sew a second chevron to the other side of the Center square, press seam toward center.

Third Row: Sew one Cat's Head and one Chevron together, press seam toward cat's head block. Then sew another Cat's Head to the other side of the chevron, press seam toward cat's head.

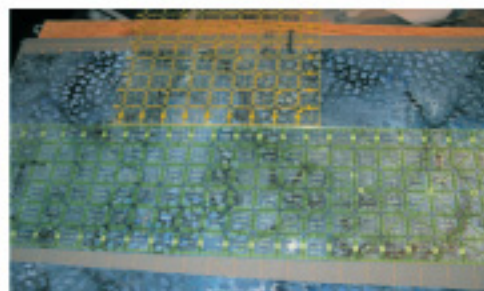
Last Step: Sew First Row to Second Row, press seam towards the second row. Sew the Third Row to the Second Row, press seam toward second row.

Once assembled, you have finished the Quilt top. You are now ready to add the batting and backing. Then you can finish the quilt by tying or quilting.

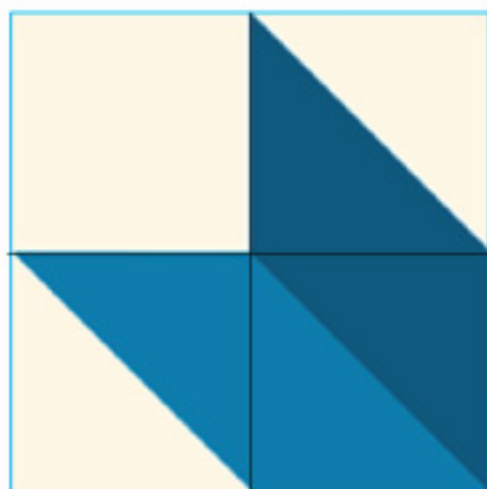
